

# Kid's Block

This pattern is comprised of 6 design squares. You use a combination of the (1) square, (1) star, (1) pokadot and (1) striped square. The last (2) square are your choice. Then they are sewn together with the invisible stitch.



**Loom:** Tadpole Knitting Board (16 pegs)

**Yarn:** Worsted weight yarn in many colors.

**Notions:** Knit hook and crochet hook, and darning needle

## Instructions

### Star Design

Cast on 16 stitches.

Row 1. Knit one row in Stockinette Stitch.

Row 2. Knit stitch #5 and #13 in the accent yarn. Then wrap all others with main color

Row 3. Knit stitch #5,6 and #12 and #13 in accent yarn.

Row 4. Knit stitch #5, 6, 7 and #11, #12 and #13 in accent yarn.

Row 5. Knit #6-#12 in accent color. Work other needles in main color.

Row 6. Knit #6-#12 in accent color. Work other needles in main color.

Row 7. Knit #5-#13 in accent color. Work other needles in main color.

Row 8. Knit row #4- #14 in accent color. Work other needles in main color.

Row 9. Knit #3-#15 in accent color. Work other needles in main color.

Row 10. Knit #3-#15 in accent color. Work other needles in main color.

Row 11. Knit #8-#12 in accent color. Work other needles in main color.

Row 12. Knit #9-#11. in accent color. Work other needles in main color.



Row 13. Knit #9-#11 in accent color. Work other needles in main color.  
 Row 14. Knit #10 in accent color. Work other needles in main color.  
 Row 15. Knit #10 in accent color. Work other needles in main color.  
 Cut yarn and tie to previous stitch.  
 Row 16. Knit row in main color. Work other needles in main color.  
 Then bind off.

### Pokadot Design

This Pokadot design is worked just like the star design. You use the accent color where the “X’s” are in the row. Start with row #1 and work to Row #16 and then bind off.

## Square Design

This again is worked like square design. Knit in main color until you get to the "Xs". Use accent yarn where the "Xs" are located. Start with row #1. After row #16 bind off.
