

El Paso Afghan

Comfy, Cozy Wool-Ease Afghan



Needed tools:
Authentic Knitting Board
38" HD Knitting Board
Knit Hook
Crochet Hook

This lovely afghan took
12 skeins of Lion Brand
Wool-Ease Yarn

2 skeins Paprika
7 skeins Fisherman
4 skeins Chocolate
Brown

Stitches used:
Rib and Stockinette

This is luscious yarn to work with, and it actually wove very quickly. It was my first project ever on the 38" large gauge knitting board, and I am certainly pleased with the outcome.

Finished size is approx 40" x 70" (including the 6" on each end of fringe)

Cast on 70 stitches (the entire board) with rib stitch (remember to use the anchor yarn).
Knit approx 40 rows (2 skeins) of Fisherman with Rib Stitch.
Knit 2 rows in Paprika with Rib Stitch
Knit 20 rows (1 skein) of Chocolate Brown in Stockinette stitch.
Knit 2 rows in Paprika with Rib Stitch.
Knit 20 rows (1 skein) of Chocolate Brown in Rib Stitch.
Knit 2 rows in Paprika with Rib Stitch.
Knit 40 rows (2 skeins) of Fsherman with Stockinette Stitch.
Knit 2 rows in Paprika with Rib Stitch.
Knit 20 rows (1 skein) of Chocolate Brown in Rib Stitch
Knit 2 rows in Paprika with Rib Stitch.
Knit 20 rows (1 skein) of Chocolate Brown in Rib Stitch.
Knit 2 rows in Paprika with Rib Stitch

Knit approx 40 rows (2 skeins) of Fisherman with Rib Stitch.

Bind off with crochet hook, beginning with the side farthest from the tail yarn, and hook loop 70 over 69, 69 over 68, and continuing with one loop until you get to number one loop and loop the tail back through, and weave the tail into the finished knitting.

For Fringe: Cut 180 threads of fringe approx 14" long. You will make 3 pieces of yarn for each crochet loop which will be put on right in the middle of each "rib." Just Lovely!
