

Fall Christmas Afghan by Sue Kreitzer

The colors represent the time of year – red and green for Christmas and the middle strip for the fall colors. The green has cross stitches scattered to represent snowflakes.



Size: 55" x 45"

28" Knitting Board

Stitches: Criss Cross and Stockinette (1st 4 rows and last 4 rows of each square is in Criss Cross stitch and the rest in Stockinette)

I used 4 different yarns from my "stash"; all of bulky weight.

This afghan is made in 3 stripes.

End stripes (make 2)

Cast On 38 stitches.

Knit 4 rows in Criss Cross Stitch, main color.

Knit 32 rows in Stockinette, main color

Knit 4 rows in Criss Cross, Main color

Knit 2 rows of white, Stockinette

Then repeat with other main color.

Knit until you have 4 sections alternating main color.

Total of 168 stitches.

The center strip- Cast On 38 stitches and knit 168 rows.
