

## Winter Afghan By Ella Roby



### Needed:

38" HD Knitting Board.  
Set at one inch spacing knit  
hook and crochet hook.

4 ply yarn  
(I used a double strand of  
Caron)

Finished size is 64" X 38"

Knit in Stockinette stitch.

Cast on all 72 pins with a double strand of green. Lay anchor yarn.

Knit 20 rows.

Next four rows alternate colors.

Alternate colors by wrapping down the board with green. Attach cream and wrap down the board with cream. Knit off. Next three rows wrap so that green is on top of cream and cream is on top of green. You may need to begin row by going straight across the board. Cut green to secure. You will continue with cream.

Knit 20 rows of cream. Knit four rows of alternating color. Cut cream and tie to secure. You will continue with green.

Knit 20 rows of green. Then 4 rows of alternating color. Cut green and secure. You will continue with cream.

Knit 20 rows of cream. Knit four rows of alternating color. Cut cream and secure. You will continue with green.

Knit 20 rows of green. Knit four rows of alternating color. Cut green and secure. You will continue with cream.

Knit 20 rows of cream.

Bind off (one thru one) Bind off end with anchor yarn. Remove anchor yarn.
