

Anniversary Scarf

This fun, soft fashion scarf can be worn anywhere. Lightweight and airy with a loose knit so that it doesn't feel heavy on a hot day. I hope you enjoy it!



Supplies:

16 peg Tadpole Knitting Board.

Yarn:

100% cotton, I Love This Cotton used in sample, 1 skein

Stitch:

Half Stockinette cast-on and stitch used throughout. See stitch instructions on how to do this new stitch.

Half Stockinette Stitch:

Place slip knot on the first peg lower board then wrap to the top board second peg and continue down the board wrapping every other peg bottom to top. When you get to the end of the board continue wrapping back down the board over the top of the previous stitches, starting with the next to last wrapped peg. Lay anchor yarn.



Some pegs will be completely empty, and all but the very last peg on the right will have two loops. After the cast on the board is worked down to the right then knit off, then wrapped to the left and knit off, rather than the full Stockinette where you always begin wrapping from the same side of the board. The first wrap of each row will always start on the second peg.

Continue in this manner until desired length – picture show approximately 225 rows. Use 1 over two crochet bind off on both ends. Remove anchor yarn and tuck in tails.
